

COLLEGE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
MINUTES OF ROAD INSPECTION
APRIL 21, 1980

College Township Council met at 1:00 p.m. to inspect streets of the Township as mandated by the Code.

The Manager and the following Council Members were present:
J. Carroll Dean, Donald E. Bailey, Gale L. Dargitz, and Dolores A. Taricani.

Generally, all streets in the Township were found to be in good shape and particularly free of potholes.

Most of the streets except where there is curbing need the berms graded which is generally routine maintenance after the winter season.

Only those streets noted for repair, other than grading of berms, are as follows:

1. Intersection of East College Avenue and Clover Road (Clover Highlands) needs paved.
2. Storm drainage ditches on Hawthorne Drive need paved.
3. Drainage ditch on Hillview Avenue and the Intersection of Elmwood Street, Clover Road, and Hillview Avenue needs paved.
4. Minor patching needed on various streets, especially some of the streets that are included in the 5-Year Street Improvement Program.
5. The following streets are scheduled for resurfacing this year: Limerock Terrace, Panorama Drive, Warnock Road, Maple Lane, Villa Crest Drive, a section of Brush Valley Road, Yardall Road (between Rainlo Street and Oakwood Drive), Houserville Road from the end of

State Highway to Intersection of Houserville Road,
Trout Road and Rock Road.

At the time of the Road Inspection, the following items were
also noted.

1. Have Mr. Beward check the two rental houses on
Whitehall Road.
2. At the Hilltop Trailer Park Maintenance Building,
there are many free standing fuel tanks that are
not within an enclosed area. I will bring this
to the attention of Mr. Beitz, the Code Administrator.
