W. Branch Road Relocation Agreement

Council discussed continued delays to receiving executed Highway Occupancy Permit from Canadian Pacific related to the W. Branch Road relocation signal project.

**Dr. Remick moved to execute a letter to Canadian Pacific relative to the W. Branch Road Relocation Agreement.
Ms. Shoemaker seconded the motion.

Brandywine Drive Sidewalk – Discussion

Council held discussion on clarifications of Brandywine Drive sidewalks and whether or not to request sidewalks on the eyebrow and/or on Dover Circle. Council agreed that Dover Circle should be included in the list of sidewalks required in Canterbury Crossing Subdivision, noting that sidewalks should go around the eyebrow as opposed to through the eyebrow. It was also agreed that either a new curb cut on Scenery Drive at Asbury or a sidewalk along Scenery Drive to connect with existing bikepath depression be installed, as per plan submitted to College Township.

Council requested that a plan be presented to staff for this overall sidewalk project.

Proposed 2011 College Township Budget Review

Council reviewed and offered comments to staff on the Proposed 2011 College Township Budget.

Changes and modifications discussed will be made by staff and incorporated into the proposed budget for adoption by Council at its November 18 meeting.
