

SPECIAL MEETING OF
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
NOVEMBER 28, 1975

The Supervisors of College Township met in a special meeting on Friday, November 28, 1975, at 4:00 p.m. in the Township Municipal Building for the purpose of discussing the proposed budget for 1976. Present were Clarence E. Trotter, Elwood G. Williams, Sr., and John H. Ziegler. Also in attendance were J. Carroll Dean, Dolores A. Taricani, and Denise Bowman Emers.

The proposed budget was reviewed on a line-by-line basis and tentatively accepted after considerable discussion.

Relative to income to the Township, two actions were taken by the Supervisors.

The first action concerned the fact that College Township's share of the Centre Region Parks and Recreation Program for the operation and maintenance of Township parks for 1976 is \$25,173.74. At the present time the Township's Park and Recreation Account is supported by a one-mill tax which is only providing half of the cost of the Township's Parks and Recreation program. The balance of the costs are presently financed out of the Township's General Fund and Revenue Sharing Account. Consideration was given to an additional one-mill tax that would provide sufficient revenue to support the Parks and Recreation program. Capital improvements in the Township parks would continue to be financed from other sources. Mr. Ziegler moved that in 1976 the Township increase the Parks and Recreation tax to two mills. Mr. Trotter seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The second item on which official action was taken was the Street Lighting Account. In 1976 the street lighting costs will be approximately

\$6,000 and the current 10 cents per front foot levy will not cover that amount. Mr. Trotter moved and Mr. Ziegler seconded the motion to raise the street lighting assessment an additional five cents per front foot. This motion passed unanimously.

The Supervisors then decided to formally present the revised proposed budget at their regular monthly meeting to be held Tuesday, December 9, 1975. Thereafter, the budget will be advertised for 20 days and officially adopted at a special meeting to be held Tuesday, December 30, 1975 at 4:00 p.m. in the Municipal Building.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
