

COLLEGE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES FOR SPECIAL MEETING
HELD JANUARY 28, 1974

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Williams at 7:30 P.M.

The following items of business were considered:

1. Chairman Williams announced that as far as he knew, no one had been in to review the proposed Budget. Ziegler moved and Trotter seconded the approval of the Budget as advertised. Unanimously passed.
2. Chairman Williams read a letter of resignation from Donald E. Mitchell. Mr. Mitchell indicated that his business responsibilities made it difficult for him to meet with the Zoning Hearing Board and thus he wished to be replaced. Trotter moved and Williams seconded the acceptance of Mr. Mitchell's resignation. Passed.
3. Trotter moved and Williams seconded the appointment of William H. Leonard to fill the unexpired one year term of Donald E. Mitchell on the Zoning Hearing Board. Passed.
4. Mr. Trotter explained the results of his investigation into the request by Mid-State Investments, Inc. for an extension of the deadline for subdivision of Final Plans. The extension requested would expire July 3, 1975. Trotter reviewed the history of the area involving both Friedman and Zimmerman

Plans. Trotter moved and Ziegler seconded the approval to permit the Mid-State extension of time as proposed. Passed.

5. Trotter moved and Ziegler seconded the motion for adjournment at 8:30 P.M.
