

MINUTES OF THE ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE COLLEGE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS  
HELD ON JANUARY 6, 1969.

The College Township Board of Supervisors met in the Municipal Building on January 6, 1969 at 7:30 p.m. All supervisors were present.

At this organizational meeting, Howard Levine was re-elected Chairman, and Lester Weaver was re-elected Secretary-Treasurer. Elwood Williams was elected Vice-Chairman and also Superintendent of Roads and Buildings for the coming year.

Mr. J. Carroll Dean was appointed to the Planning Commission to fill the unexpired term of Warner Eliot, who resigned. Mr. Eliot's term would have expired on January, 1972.

Mr. Ernest J. Oelbermann was appointed to a two-year term to the University Area Joint Authority.

Mr. Donald E. Mitchell was re-appointed to the Zoning Hearing Board for a three-year term.

Mr. Reed McCormick was appointed Township Solicitor.

No changes were made in the tax rates. The one-half percent wage tax was continued and the real estate taxes were re-enacted as before, with 2 mills allotted to the general fund, 1 mill to the Recreation and Parks fund and 1 mill to the Equipment fund.
