

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD BY THE
COLLEGE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
IN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING
JANUARY 6, 1975

As mandated, a special meeting of the College Township Supervisors was held specifically to decide on the organizational structure for the current year. The meeting was called to order at 4:10 p.m. by Mr. Williams. Mr. Trotter moved, Mr. Ziegler seconded a motion that the same organization be continued for 1975 as follows:

Mr. Williams as Chairman

Mr. Trotter as Vice Chairman

Mr. Ziegler as Secretary-Treasurer

Mr. Williams as Superintendent of Roads and Buildings.

Unanimously passed.

Mr. Ziegler moved, Mr. Trotter seconded the motion that Reed McCormick be continued as College Township Solicitor. Unanimously passed.

Mr. Ziegler moved, Mr. Trotter seconded a motion that the attached proposed wage increases for College Township be approved. Mr. Williams pointed out that the Supervisors' action relative to wages was subject to mandated review and approval by College Township Board of Auditors. The wage increases proposed amount to approximately 9%. Comments during the discussion were that generally the Supervisors are well pleased with the performance of all College Township employees but especially is this so relative to the secretary, zoning officer, and road supervisor. Passed unanimously.

A letter of resignation from the College Township Parks and Recreation Commission was read from Donald V. Joyce. Mr. Trotter moved, Mr. Ziegler seconded, and passed unanimously the motion to accept his resignation and

Mr. Ziegler was instructed to write a letter of appreciation as per the attached. At the next regular meeting, the Supervisors will appoint 3 new members to the College Township Parks and Recreation Commission.

A letter from the State College Borough Mayor Jo Hayes was read in which he solicited aid for the upcoming bi-centennial celebration. College Township Supervisors decided to ask Marvin Lee or someone he designates to attend the meetings to be held by the Borough and to handle the College Township participation in the COG program.

Mr. Trotter moved, Mr. Ziegler seconded the motion to set the regular meeting dates for 1975 as the second Tuesday of each month to begin at 7:30 p.m. Passed unanimously. Dates to be advertised as follows:

March 11	September 9
April 8	October 14
May 13	November 18
June 10	December 9

Supervisors also decided to advertise the unchanged tax rates as approved at their last meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 4:25 P.M.
