

ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF  
THE COLLEGE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL  
JANUARY 3, 1977

JOHN ZIEGLER CALLED THE COLLEGE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL TO ORDER AT 7:30 P.M. ON JANUARY 3, 1977. COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT WERE: DONALD BAILEY, CARROLL DEAN, DOLORES TARICANI, AND CLARENCE TROTTER. MANAGER ELWOOD WILLIAMS WAS ALSO PRESENT. THE RE-ORGANIZATION MEETING HAD BEEN CALLED TO ELECT OFFICERS -- A CHAIRMAN AND A VICE-CHAIRMAN FOR THE COMING YEAR, AND TO APPOINT TWO SOLICITORS, ONE FOR THE COUNCIL AND ONE FOR THE ZONING HEARING BOARD.

TROTTER OPENED NOMINATIONS BY NOMINATING ZIEGLER FOR CHAIRMAN. BAILEY MOVED THE NOMINATIONS BE CLOSED AND TROTTER SECONDED THE MOTION. THE VOTE ON THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUS. THE SECRETARY WAS INSTRUCTED TO CAST THE AFFIRMATIVE BALLOT.

DEAN NOMINATED CLARENCE TROTTER FOR VICE-CHAIRMAN. TARICANI MOVED THE NOMINATIONS BE CLOSED AND DEAN SECONDED THE MOTION. IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY PASSED. THE SECRETARY CAST A YES VOTE FOR THE NOMINATION.

BAILEY MOVED TO APPOINT REED MCCORMICK THE COUNCIL'S SOLICITOR. TARICANI SECONDED THE MOTION AND IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

TROTTER MOVED THAT LILLIAN RAYCROFT BE APPOINTED AS SOLICITOR FOR THE ZONING HEARING BOARD. DEAN SECONDED THE MOTION AND IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY PASSED.

A NEW MEETING NIGHT WAS DISCUSSED. TROTTER MOVED THE COUNCIL MEET THE 2ND THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH. BAILEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND IT WAS CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 8:00 P.M.
