

COLLEGE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
MINUTES OF ROAD INSPECTION
APRIL 20, 1984

College Township Council Members met at 1:00 p.m. for the purpose of inspecting the Township streets as mandated by the Township Code, and also observe certain parking problem areas.

Those present were: Max Hartswick and Fred Smith, Council Members;
Tom Lechner, Manager and
Garry Williams, Maintenance Foreman.

Generally, the streets in the Township were observed to be in relatively good condition except as noted below.

- .. Big Hollow Road - shoulder edge of road near Flower Gardens needs repair and several pot holes near the fire school.
- .. Bottorf Drive - water ponding on shoulder near Houseville Road (This will be corrected as provided under the 1984 Storm Water Project Program.).
- .. Campbell Road - needs work at Whitehall Road Intersection.
- .. Clover Road - needs work around Pikeview Road Intersection.
- .. Dale Street - needs work at Pike Street Intersection and storm basin needs to be corrected.
- .. Evergreen Road - road construction settlement has caused some depressions in cul-de-sac.
- .. First Avenue - road depressed at water line.
- .. Fox Hollow Road Bikeway - will have continual problems with stones and dirt.
- .. Gibbons Street - berm and edge of cartway need work.
- .. Greenbriar Drive - needs some patching at Hunter Avenue Intersection.
- .. Henszey Street - water line construction has caused dip and curb broken and needs to be replaced.
- .. Hickory Road Intersection at Willow Avenue - loose stones from water run-off.
- .. Hunter Avenue - has cracks and needs to be sealed.
- .. Jalice Circle - severe line excavation settlement has caused dips in the cartway.

- .. Matilda Avenue (380) - has broken berm.
- .. Mayberry Lane (East) - has big drop-off onto stone road to park.
- .. Mobile Avenue - needs patch work at intersection with Squirrel Drive.
- .. Mt. Nittany Road - needs shoulder repaired at R/A Crossing.
- .. Oak Lane at Intersection of Fairlawn - needs patch work.
- .. Oakwood Drive at Branch Road - needs shoulder build-up.
- .. Orchard Road near University Barns - needs berms addressed.
- .. Pennsylvania Avenue (West) - needs patch work.
- .. Shoferd Lane at Watkins Road Intersection - needs patch work.
- .. Spring Lea Drive - has several depressions in the cartway where water lines have been repaired.
- .. Spring Street - has some cracks near hill and water problems have caused the edge of the cartway to wash away.
- .. Squirrel Drive - very rough along edges and top of hill requires extensive patching. This road will have to be repaved in the near future.
- .. Summit Road - has several pot holes along the edge of the cartway.
- .. Trout Road - will require some shoulder repairs and water has caused some breaks in the cartway near the bridge.
- .. Villa Crest Drive - run-off water from behind the Church causes stones to continually run out onto the cartway.
- .. Willow Circle at Intersection with Willow Avenue - needs shoulder repairs.
- .. Yardal Road (East) - in poor condition for one block between Rainlo Street and Oakwood Drive. (This is scheduled for repairing during summer of 1984.)

Several parking problems were pointed out around the Lemont Village District. Spring Street around apartments, Grandview Road around the apartment complexes, and Yardal Road.

The Road Inspection was concluded at 4:50 p.m.
