

SPECIAL MEETING CALLED BY THE
COLLEGE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
HELD IN THE COLLEGE TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING
ON AUGUST 13, 1973

A Special Meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at 12:00 Noon on Monday, August 13, 1973 in the Supervisors Office. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Elwood Williams. Mr. Weaver and Mr. Trotter were also in attendance. Also present was Norman Katz of Penn State Engineering.

Mr. Weaver moved that Mr. Trotter be elected as Vice-Chairman of the Board. Mr. Williams seconded this motion and the motion was carried unanimously.

The names of persons selected to serve on the Planning Commission were read as follows: Joe Meyer, who will serve Gale Dargitz's term until 1975; Claire Brown, who will serve Clarence Trotter's term until 1976; Ronald Weis whose term will be from 8/1/73 until 8/1/77; and Robert ^WHerman whose term will be from 8/1/73 until 8/1/77. It was moved by Mr. Weaver that these names be accepted. This motion was seconded by Mr. Trotter and motion was unanimously carried.

Several Final Plans were signed by the Supervisors and the Planning Commission Chairman and Secretary. One from Stocker Chevrolet and one from the Mid-State Investments, Inc.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:30 Noon.
