CALL TO ORDER:

Vice-Chair Shoemaker called to order a Special Council Meeting at 5:00 PM, that meeting having been duly advertised for the purpose of reviewing the 2011 – 2015 Capital Improvement Program.

Messrs. Brumbaugh and Williams led Council through each of the sections of the 2011 to 2015 Capital Improvement Program.

Mr. Brumbaugh noted that a reimbursement payment for the work on Trout Road Bridge should be received prior to the end of 2010.

A number of changes were made to the document, the following requiring staff follow-up action.

- Review and update the documents with the bike path snow removal contractor so that removal can continue as currently contracted.
- Review the Pike Street Traffic Calming project with the Centre Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) so that College Township is in a position to take advantage of any financial assistance that might become available.
- Remind CRCOG of the importance of a complete equipment replacement schedule similar to the schedule College Township utilizes.
