

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COLLEGE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON OCTOBER 21, 1971

A special meeting of the College Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Municipal Building on October 21, 1971, immediately proceeding the Planning Commission meeting. Board members Williams and Weaver were present.

The meeting was to approve the plans of Ira Whiteman to replot two smaller pieces of land, of the Mary E. Whiteman Subdivision, and make one lot still smaller than the minimum requirements of one acre.

During the Planning Commission meeting it was decided that the decision was up to the Zoning Hearing Board. A hearing had been set up by the Zoning Board for Mr. Whiteman but, evidently he was not informed. A telephone call by Mr. Dargitz of the Planning Commission to Chairman, John Ziegler discovered that a decision had been rendered and that Mr. Whiteman would receive it in a week or so.

Thus, Mr. Whiteman did not need approval by either the Planning Commission or the Supervisors.
