

MINUTES OF ROAD INSPECTION BY THE

On Monday, October 14, 1974, Supervisors Trotter, Williams and Ziegler between 3:30 and 6:30 P.M. conducted the annual inspection of College Township roads as mandated by law. Of the approximately 27.35 miles (24.00 paved, 3.35 unpaved) of road for which the Township is currently responsible, almost all were considered to be in excellent condition. A small section of Struble Road needs repaving. Noteworthy was the 1974 paving of the Brush Valley Road (above Oak Hall) which completes the paving of the College Township section of that road.
