

MINUTES OF COLLEGE TOWNSHIP

ROAD INSPECTION

MAY 17, 1979

College Township Council and the Manager met at 1:00 p.m. to inspect the roads of the Township as mandated by the Code.

Generally, all roads in the Township were found to be in good shape and particularly free of breaks and potholes.

Most of the roads, except where there is curbing, need the berms graded which is generally routine maintenance after the winter season. Only those roads and streets noted for repair, other than grading of berms, are as follows:

1. Brush Valley Road should be put on the 5-Year Road Program for resurfacing probably in 1980.
2. Campbell Road - the section between the intersection of Wildot Drive and the intersection of Ronan Drive to be built this year.
3. Carolean Industrial Drive - the section from the intersection of Struble Road east to the property line of Columbia Gas Co. needs some of the base replaced and that section resurfaced. This will be done this year.
4. First Avenue in Lemont - the west end of First Avenue, from the intersection of Nixon Drive east to the area where the street is being extended another 2500 feet, needs resurfaced. This will be put on the 1980 Paving Plan. The new section of this street will be completed this year.
5. Hawthorne Drive - the area where the Water Company repaired a water leak needs the amosite replaced. Also the berms on the section from the intersection of Clover Road up the hill should be amosited to prevent washout.
6. Limerock Terrace - needs some patching and should be put on the 5-Year Plan.
7. Mobile Avenue - at intersection of Squirrel Drive needs patching.

8. Mt. Nittany Road - needs patching.
9. Oak Ridge Avenue - needs some minor patching.
10. Orchard Road - is scheduled to be resurfaced this year. Presently negotiating with County Commissioners for additional County Aid Funds to help finance this project.
11. Shiloh Road - needs some patching.
12. Spring Street - needs some patching.
13. Spring Lea Drive - storm sewers have been installed from Houserville Road to the intersection of Willow Avenue and from the intersection of Willow Avenue to the intersection of Hickory Road the berms are being amised. This project is about completed.

At the time of the Road Inspection, the following items were also noted:

- * At the end of Oak Ridge Avenue at the State College Borough Line, erect the following sign "NOW LEAVING COLLEGE TOWNSHIP".
- * At the Hilltop Trailer Park maintenance building, there are many free-standing fuel tanks that are not within an enclosed area. Mr. Beitz, Code Administrator, will be informed of this situation.
