**MINUTES OF COLLEGE TOWNSHIP
ROAD INSPECTION**

MAY 8, 1978

**WORRY
FREE!**

The Manager and College Township Council met to inspect the roads of the Township as mandated by the Code.

Trotter suggested that the Township should inventory all roads and establish a five-year road program with notations as to building, maintenance, contractor, etc. Remainder of Council and the Manager agreed with Trotter's suggestion.

Generally all roads in the Township were found to be in good shape and practically free of breaks and potholes. Only those roadways noted for repairs are listed as follows:

1. Clover has serious berm erosion,
2. Pennsylvania needs patching,
3. Squirrel and Mobile need berm rebuilding,
4. Oak Ridge should be investigated as a possible access to the Smith Subdivision,
5. Borough sign on Cemetery needs repairs - notify Borough,
6. Intersection of Cemetery and Branch still has drainage problem. PennDOT and Borough should be contacted again about possible drainage diversion,
7. Hunter needs patching at the intersection,
8. Rainlo and Yardal corner needs patching,
9. Merry Hill will probably need resurfacing in 1979.
10. Shady to be resurfaced in 1978,

11. Mary has rough railroad crossing which will not be repaired because it slows traffic,
12. Lemont parking has not been resolved as per recent Council decision,
13. Mountain needs hot patching and rough grading on the end,
14. Nixon entrance to park is all right. (Several tables are to be placed in the off-Matilda Park this summer),
15. Where are the guard rails on Limerock?
16. Carolean needs patching,
17. Summit and Benner Intersection needs resurfacing,
18. Shiloh needs hot patching and berm rebuilding,
19. Fairlawn and Oak Intersection needs hot patching,
20. Spring Lea needs culvert pipes on the south side,
21. Willow needs berm work,
22. Orchard section adjacent to Puddintown should be resurfaced summer 1978,
23. Hospital right-of-way should be graded smooth to permit machine mowing,
24. Fox Hollow and Orchard Intersection needs resurfacing,
25. Another serious effort should be made to obtain sufficient width for Campbell,
26. Harris Acres needs berm work everywhere mainly because of sloppy refilling,
27. Hubler Intersection needs patching,
28. In Panorama Village the Harris Township Water Company should refill the ditch dug to solve a drainage problem,

At the time of the road inspection the following items were also noted:

29. Nydegger appears to have numerous cars without licenses,
30. Check with our Commonwealth Legislators to learn if all County receipts of Liquid Fuels Funds can be discontinued,
31. Check 3 campers parked at George Lattimer's on Shady,
32. Hartman residence at corner of Gerald and Dreibelbis is a trashy mess,
33. Check Osterhoudt sign (permit?),
34. Some houses on Oak Ridge have no house numbers,
35. Check again garage sales on Oak Ridge,
36. The College Township Ordinance requiring either street completion or a bond should be uniformly and equitably enforced throughout the Township.
