

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COLLEGE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS HELD ON
APRIL 12, 1969

A special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of College Township was held in the Municipal Building at 1:00, p.m., April 12, 1969. All supervisors were present. Also present was Dick Campbell, Solicitor for the College-Harris Joint Authority, and Dan Stearns.

At this meeting the supervisors discussed a problem brought up by Dan Stearns concerning a requirement of the sewer authority that barns be hooked up to the sewer. Mr. Stearns was concerned about this problem since his barn had no bathroom facilities or other facilities for cleaning or washing equipment as would be necessary in a dairy enterprise. The supervisors decided to ask the Authority for a policy statement, and Mr. Campbell stated that he would discuss the matter with member of the Authority.

Mr. Williams moved and Mr. Weaver seconded that three ordinances be adopted as follows:

- No. 37 --granting the College-Harris Authority the right-of-way to proceed on streets and roads of the township and regulating manner in which exercised.
- No. 38 -- re construction of the sewage collection system and requiring residents and property owners whose property is 150 feet from the collection system to connect.
- No. 39 -- requiring connection by owners, specifying manner of connection, prohibiting connection of privy vaults, septic tanks, etc.

The Ordinances were adopted by the Board.

Meeting adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
