

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COLLEGE TOWNSHIP HELD ON
MAY 24, 1969

The special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of College Township was held in the Municipal Building at 1:00 p.m. on May 24, 1969. All supervisors were present.

This meeting was called to consider passage of the Regional Sign Ordinance. Only one person, Mr. Robert Hoff, of the Centre County Memorial Park was in attendance at the meeting.

Mr. Hoff had earlier requested by letter that the cemetery be exempt from paying a fee for sign licensing since he felt they were eligible for the same consideration as golf course and country clubs which are exempted from paying fees.

The Board approved the adoption of the Regional Sign Ordinance with the provision that cemeteries could apply to the Sign Inspector for a waiver from the licensing fee. Mr. Earl Maize, Township Zoning Officer, was designated as Sign Inspector for the Township.

Mr. Williams was requested to check with the other townships and the borough to work out details of enforcement, application forms, license forms and stickers for attachments to signs.

The Board commended Barash Advertising Agency for withdrawing its suit against the Borough of State College, which had already adopted the Sign Ordinance, and recognizing the desires of the community for some sort of sign regulation.

The supervisors discussed the three bids opened at the last regular meeting for the traffic light at the Houserville intersection. It was decided that since the low bid from Shaffer Electric was for solid state equipment and since the Highway Department had informed the township this equipment had not yet met final approval from the Highway Department, but only provisional approval, that the bid would be awarded to K & B Electric, the next higher bidder, whose equipment would meet with state approval.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 2:00 p.m.

WHEREAS the representatives of the District Office of the State Department of Highways at Clearfield, Pennsylvania have advised the Board that the equipment (solid state type) upon which Shaffer Electric Company of Bellefonte, Pennsylvania, based its low bid of \$6,610 for the traffic signals at the intersection of Houserville Road and Route 26 had not yet received final clearance from the Highway Department at Harrisburg,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of College Township award the bid for the traffic lights to the next lowest bidder, K. & B. Electric Company of Snowshoe, Pa. in the amount of \$6,838.31.
