

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COLLEGE TOWNSHIP, MARCH 19, 1968

The special meeting of the College Township Board of Supervisors was held on March 19, 1968 in the Municipal Building at 7:30 p.m. All supervisors were present.

The Chairman announced that there were three items of business, the adoption of the budget, the consideration of request for rezoning from Gordon D. Kissinger and the consideration of request for rezoning from Ross D. Lowder.

Adoption of Budget for 1968 The 1968 budget having been duly advertised and made available in the township offices for the legal number of days was presented for adoption. There being no further discussion, it was moved by Williams and seconded by Weaver that the budget be adopted as presented. The motion carried.

Request for rezoning of portion of Dalevue-Centre Hills subdivisions as proposed to Planning Commission was presented and discussed briefly. There being no question or objections from the audience to the re-zoning request, it was moved by Williams and seconded by Weaver, that section of land as described in the legal notice attached be rezoned from R-1 to R-2 residential. The motion carried.

Request from Ross D. Lowder for rezoning changes on his property located in College Township was presented to the Board. After very brief discussion with Mr. Lowder in which he indicated that he was not entirely pleased with the rezoning of a portion of his land (as described in the legal notice attached) from R-2 to R-1, the Chairman stated that the Board could only act on the rezoning request as recommended by the Planning Commission and as advertised for hearing, and he inquired whether Mr. Lowder was agreeable to the rezoning request as presented. Mr. Lowder stated that he had no objection. It was moved by Weaver and seconded by Williams that the section of Mr. Lowder's property, as described in the legal advertisement be rezoned from R-1 to R-2 residential, and, further, that the second section, as described in the legal advertisement, be rezoned from R-2 to R-1 residential. The motion carried.

Citizen attendance at the meeting was small, consisting of two persons other than Mr. Kissinger and Mr. Lowder. Mr. Everhart, who arrived late, after the rezoning requests had been considered expressed some concern and asked some questions about the proposed development of Mr. Lowder's tract. Since the business before the meeting tonight concerned only the rezoning request, he was referred to the Planning Commission meeting on May 1st, at which time, presumably, Mr. Lowder's sketch plan for a proposed subdivision would be presented for discussion.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
