

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COLLEGE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
HELD JANUARY 4, 1972

The regular meeting of the College Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Municipal Building January 4, 1972 at 7:30 P.M. All Supervisors were present.

The minutes of the special meeting December 30, 1971, and the organization meeting January 3, 1972, were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was read and approved as follows:

Balance for November 30 - \$26,602.63

Receivables for December- 10,729.68

Total \_ \$37,332.31

The Board approved payment of bills in the amount of \$13,377.95, leaving a balance for December 31<sup>st</sup> of \$23,954.56. Mr Skinner moved that the bills be paid. It was passed unanimously.

An announcement was made by Mr. Williams that the map of the interchange of the Bypass with Benner Pike will be posted in the Municipal Building for anyone interested. A notice will also be put in the newspaper advertising this announcement.

Mr. Williams also reported that the Police Report for 1971 will be reviewed at the next Supervisors meeting.

The problem of snowmobile operation in Spring Creek Park was brought to the Supervisors attention. Apparently there is no exact ruling prohibiting the use of these vehicles. It was discussed that a possible ordinance be provided for designated areas where the machines may be operated. The Board agreed to look into the matter.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:45PM.
