**CALL TO ORDER:**

Chair Francke called to order at 7:03 PM the duly advertised November 3, 2016, College Township Public Hearing on proposed Resolution R-16-25, Transfer of Liquor License #R-20680 into College Township.

In compliance with Act 141 of 2000, proposed Resolution R-16-25, Transfer of Restaurant Liquor License #R-20680 into College Township, went to a duly advertised public hearing for the purpose of receiving public comment on the above-mentioned proposed Resolution. Act 141 of 2000 authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve the transfer of restaurant liquor licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county following an open, public hearing and the subsequent approval of a resolution approving the transfer of a restaurant liquor license into a municipality from within the same county.

Mark F. Kozar, Esq., Flaherty and O'Hara, introduced Mr. Alexander Ororbia, Weis Markets' Architectural Department Sr. Manager, prior to presenting Weis Markets' request for Council's approval of Resolution R-16-25, as referenced above. Mr. Kozar described the approximately 2,000-square-foot area in the South Hills Plaza Weis Markets, which would contain seating for 30 for on-site consumption and beer to go. Weis employees working in this section of the store will be required to have earned their certification through the Responsible Alcohol Management Program (RAMP). Atty. Kozar added that the developer anticipates acquiring a wine expansion permit in the near future.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

No public comments were forthcoming.

Hearing no public comment, Chair called for a motion to close the public hearing.
